They had a traditional Jewish wedding with a huppah. The ceremony was conducted by a rabbi from the synagogue where my grandfather Abram was a gabbai. There were many guests at their wedding besides their brothers and sisters and their families. The newly weds settled down with my mother's sister Zhenia in her apartment in Staroportfrankovskaya street. My mother quit her job after getting married. She could afford to stay at home. My father provided well for the family. I know little about my father because he left mother in 1931 for a cashier woman from his store.
