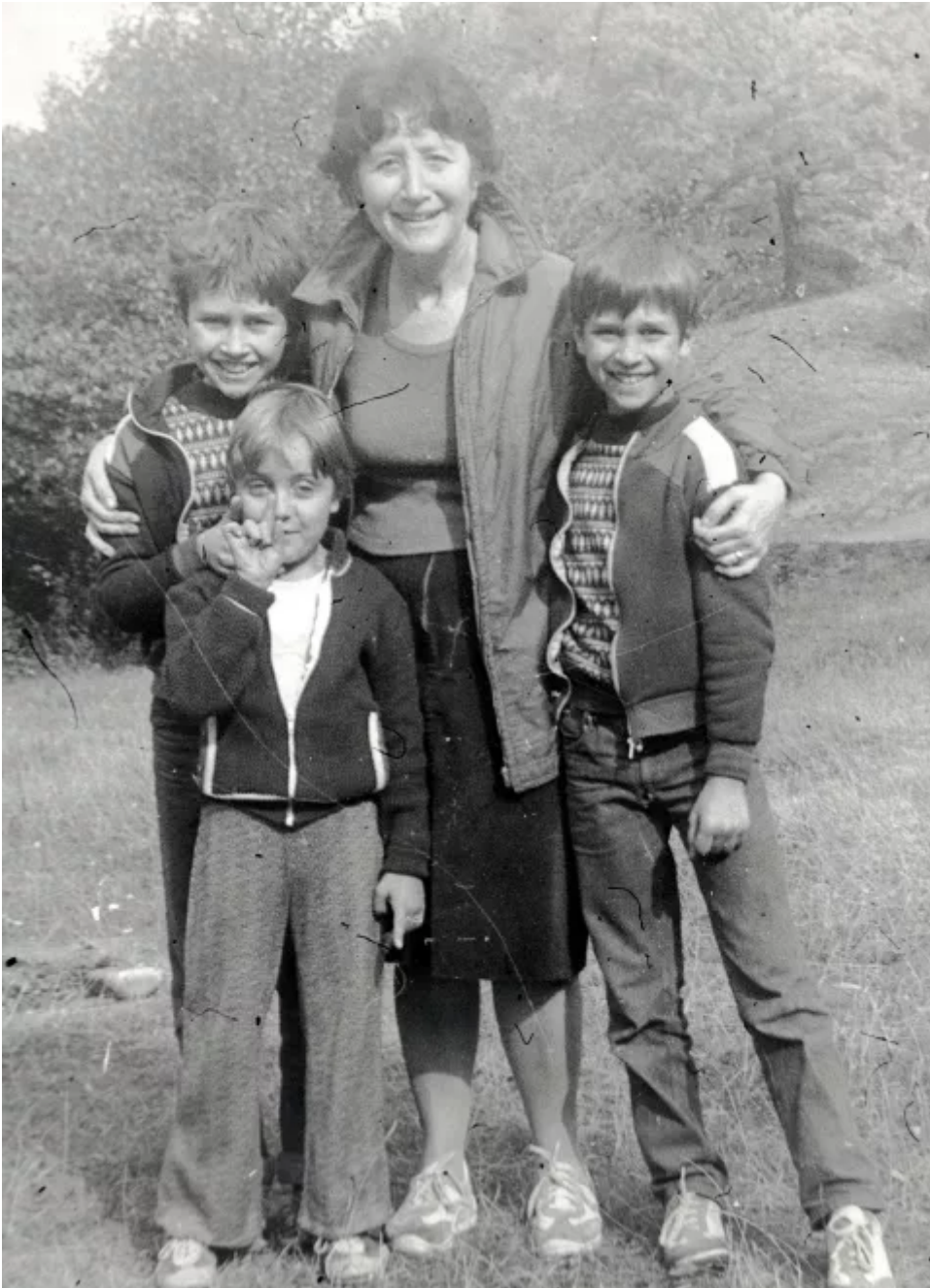


Linka Isaeva With Her Grandchildren
