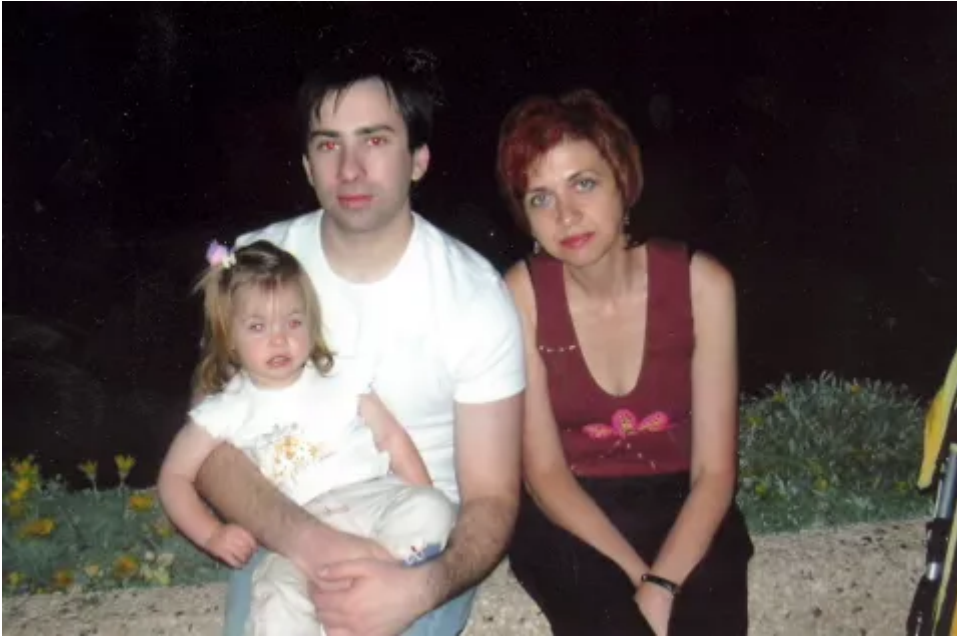


Chaya Rozenburgene With Her Son Elan And Granddaughter Michalia
