


# Pavel Werner's Pre-War Report Card

Besides this, back then I must have read completely all the pocket-novels, back then they were published as a series, someone scrounged them up for me, and there wasn't a single pocket-novel that I hadn't read. I loved to read.

By the third grade I was barred from attending school by the Germans, I attended secret classes for Jewish children. We would meet by the Pardubice synagogue and the classes were held in the

rabbi's apartment.
