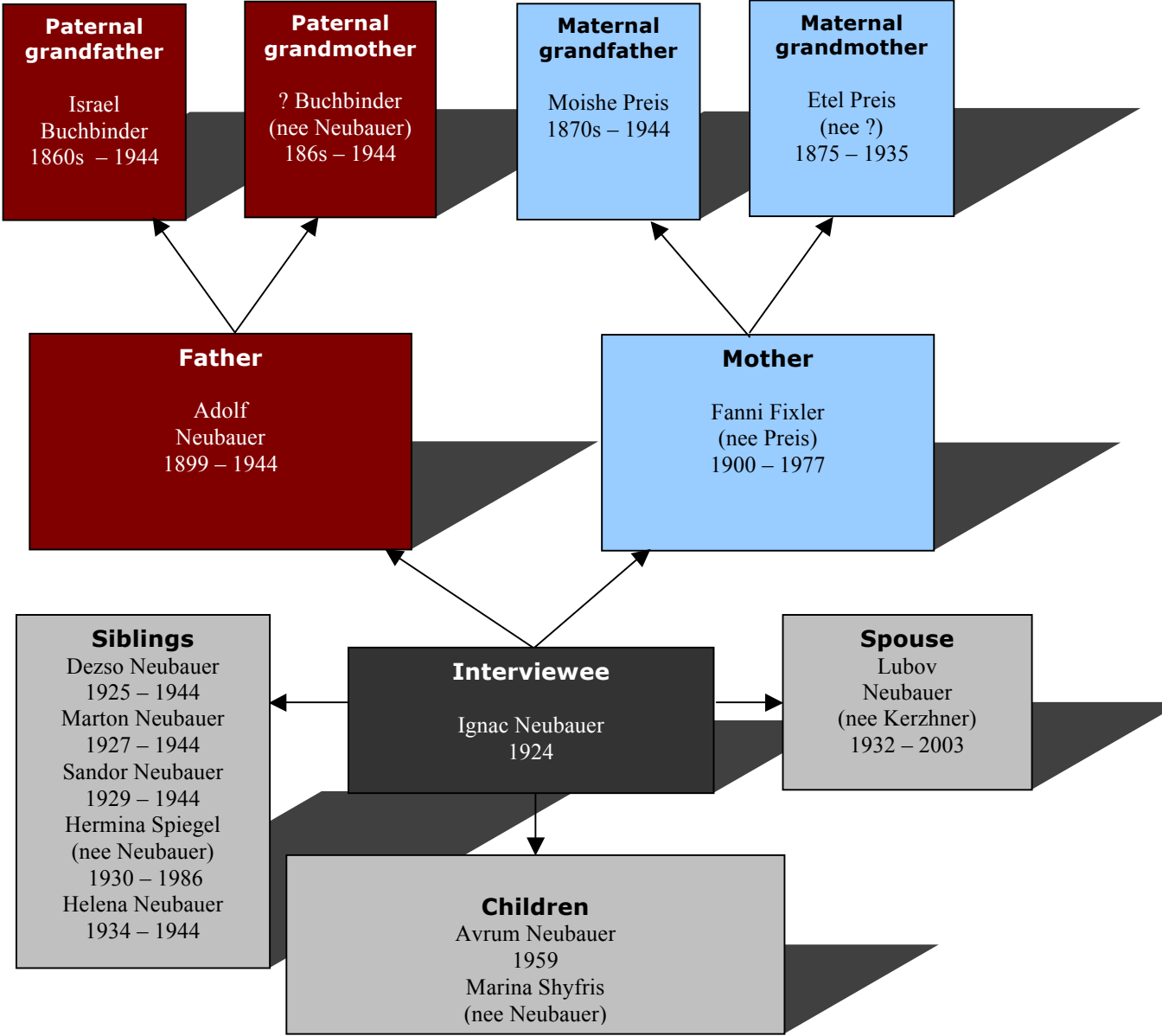

Riva Steinberg (nee Preis)	Kisdobrony after 1900 – Auschwitz 1944	Housewife	Wolf Steinberg Jew ? – work battalion, Ukraine 1942	Riva had 6 children. 2 older sons were in work battalions. One of them perished, one survived. He moved to Israel in the 1970s. 4 younger children perished in Auschwitz in 1944	Riva was religious. She observed Jewish traditions, went to the synagogue on Sabbath and Jewish holidays, celebrated Sabbath and Jewish holidays, followed kashrut
Bernat Preis	Kisdobrony after 1900 – Israel 1980s	Shoemaker	His 1 st wife perished in Auschwitz in 1944 His 2 nd wife died in Israel in the 1990s	Two children in his 1 st marriage, perished in Auschwitz in 1944 Two daughters from his second marriage live in Israel	Bernat was religious. He observed Jewish traditions, went to the synagogue on Sabbath and Jewish holidays, celebrated Sabbath and Jewish holidays, followed kashrut
