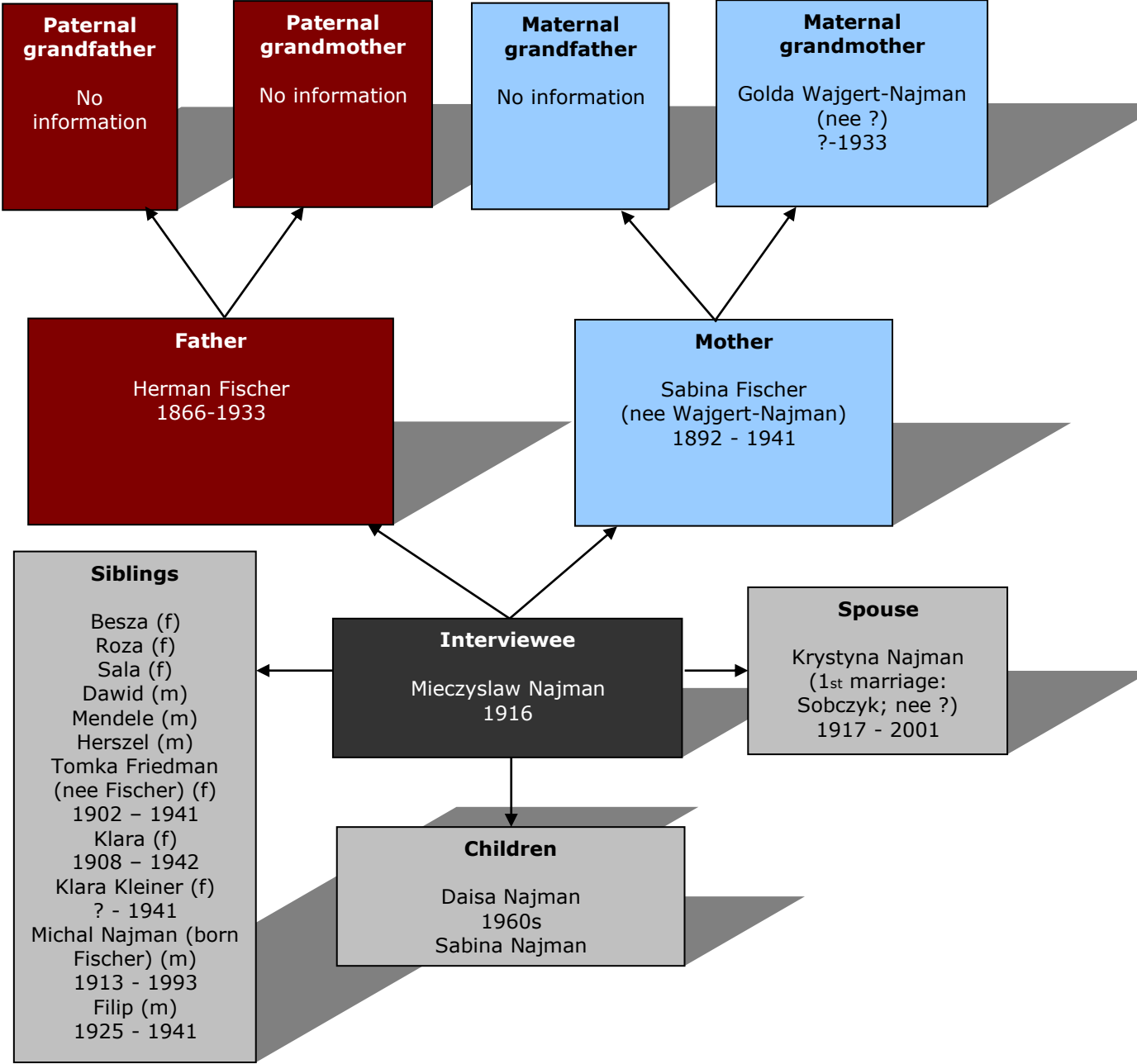


Family Tree
