

Where else did he live? Ekaterinoslav, Kiev, Alma-Ata (evacuation)

Where and when did he die? Kiev, September, 14, 1972

What sort of education did he have? School of commerce

What sort of work did he do? Commercial director in various shops or smaller companies

What was his level of religiosity? He was not religious, not keep, but he remembered the traditions

What was his mother tongue? Yiddish Army service: Which army and what years? None

She was religious: she regularly went to the synagogue, observed traditions, celebrated Sabbath and Jewish holidays, always wore a black shawl, lit candles on Sabbath and did no work on this day, they fasted at Yom-Kippur, celebrated Purim, Pesah, Hanukkah and other holidays.

What was her mother tongue? Yiddish

What sort of education did she have? Grammar school (8 years), one year at the Medical University

What sort of work did she do? Advertising agent, later artist on fabrics

What was her level of religiosity? Atheists

What was her mother tongue? Russian.

Tell me about her brothers and sisters. (name, date of birth and death, occupation, place of residence, family, etc.) Rosa, 1900 – 1964, Kiev, Manager in medical institutions , daughter Gusta. Evgenia, 1905 – 1964, Kiev, daughter Mila, son Ilia. Where was she during the Holocaust? Evacuation: Kharkov, Stalingrad, Alma-Ata

If she survived, what did she do after? Painted patterns on fabrics

Your mother's father's name? Solomon Kats (Zelman - other his Jewish name)

Where and when was he born? Place unknown, 1860s

Where else did he live? Kiev

Where and when did he die? Babiy Yar, 1941

What sort of education did he have? Heder

What sort of work did he do? Merchant of Guild II, owned a butcher's shop

What was his level of religiosity?

I don't know whether he was religious. He never prayed in my presence, but I know that he observed Sabbath and celebrated holidays.

What was his mother tongue? Yiddish

What was her level of religiosity? Wasn't very religious. They only celebrated the main holidays and very rarely went to the synagogue.

What was her mother tongue? Yiddish Tell me about her brothers and sisters. (name, date of birth and death, occupation, place of residence, family, etc.) Bencion Kulinskiy, ? – 1937, Kiev, daughters Dusia, Esia; Liza Kulinskaya, ? – 1924 died from diphtheria, daughters Rita and Rosa.

Where was he during the Holocaust? Shot in the Kiev, in Babiy Yar in 1941
